Volunteering – Step-by-Step

- The Library has a variety of on-going volunteer projects or one-time tasks. Some volunteers sign up to work on a regular schedule, while others come in when they have free time.
- First, fill out a volunteer application form at the front desk and let us know about yourself and the kind of projects and tasks you are interested in.
- For some projects you may be asked to come in at a specific time for training and then work independently.



ADOPT-A-SHELF

Help us keep our books, DVDs and audiobooks in order by “reading” one or more shelves every two weeks or so. Choose



fiction or non-fiction, adult or juvenile. Place the items in alphabetical order or by Dewey Decimal

number, as required.

Your shelves will be identified with your initials and you will record your volunteer time in the log when you are done.

HOME DELIVERY

Volunteers deliver items to patrons who are unable to come to the library. Talk with your assigned patron to learn the kinds of materials he or she would like, then schedule a delivery time.

SUMMER BOOKMOBILE

Volunteers make weekly trips during the summer to an off-site location to bring books to kids who may not be able to come to the library



in any other way. Choose books, interact with children, and encourage them to read--then help hand out awards at the end of the summer. It’s fun and rewarding!
