

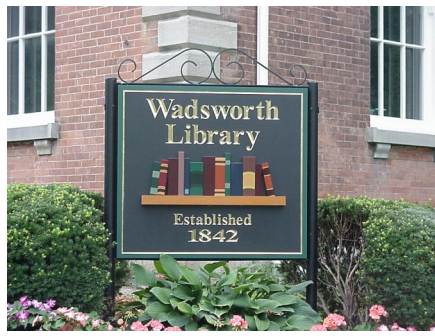

Wadsworth Library Home Delivery Service...



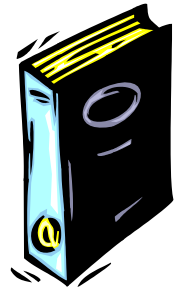
...provides library services to house-bound patrons who reside in the Towns of Geneseo and Groveland.

A house-bound person is someone of any age who is unable to visit the library due to a long- or short-term illness, condition or disability. This includes senior citizens who do not drive.

Each patron is individually profiled and matched with a volunteer on a one-to-one basis. The volunteer will visit the library and select reading and other materials for the patron. Library staff can assist in filling patron requests.



Once library materials have been selected and checked out using the patron's own library card, volunteers will contact the patron to coordinate delivery and return of materials.
