Preschool Storytime II

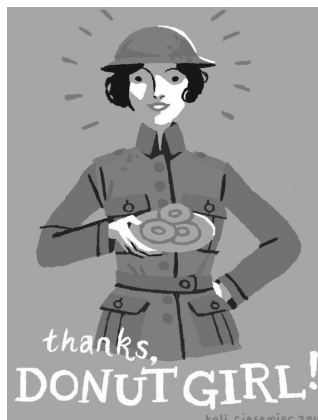
